RATIONALE:

To change the fuel allowed to be used in the Formula Vee Category.

ACTION:

Amend 2009 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport – Specification of Automobiles – 1st Category: Racing Cars – Formula Vee as follows:

6. FUEL

Each competitor must only use pump fuel Only fuel, as defined in Schedule G **of the 2009 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, except that all fuel must be used without any additives**. (refer “General Requirements for Cars and Drivers” in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport), may be used.

Formula Vee Rule Change, Fuel

Please note the following bulletin B09-006, has been released by CAMS and is implemented as of the 22nd January 2009.

Also the following clarification on the definition of pump fuel has been received from CAMS.

“The reference to "roadside retail bowzers" in Schedule G is only used to determine which fuels comply with the definition of a pump fuel. In this case, I do not believe that a mobile bowser tanker at a country airport or a bowser at a race track would comply with this definition. Further to this, any fuel that complies with the definition can be used whether the actual fuel being used has been delivered from a bowser or a drum.”
