Structures 2007**

Formula Vee racing cars compete in two categories depending on engine size:

Gold Star 1,600cc - A new and growing category introduced to WA in 2006. 4 cars competed in 2007.

Silver Star 1,200cc – Largely unchanged in over 40 years of racing, 18 cars competed in 2007.

In 2007, all meetings were held at Barbagallo Raceway, and were organised by the West Australian Sporting Car Club (WASCC) under the auspices of the Confederation of Australian Motorsport (CAMS). There are generally 3 races of 8 laps per meeting. Point scores are as follows for all championships and categories:
