Dear President.

From Wednesday 25th July the CAMS office was contacted by a number of concerned members from the Formula Vee Association surrounding the eligibility of a number of vehicles which participated in the Spices Catering Cup held at Barbagallo Raceway on the 8th July 2007.

It is alleged that a number of vehicles took part in the aforementioned competition possibly making use of a component that was not permitted. Having this situation addressed retrospectively is difficult and not feasible in this instance.

The Executive of the State Council have discussed the matter at length and decided that as no protest was lodged as was the competitors right, also that Stewards of the meeting had not been made aware of the issue (or approached to assist in sourcing a solution considering the number of alleged vehicles involved), it cannot afford any assistance.

The Executive suggests that technical regulations which are available to everyone free of charge, or the eligibility advisor for the category be consulted when new components are sourced to ensure that what is fitted is indeed permitted.
